Separation and divorce are stressful for all members of a family. This educational program focuses on the needs of children during separation and divorce. As a concerned parent, you will want to learn how to help your child through this difficult time.

- The program consists of 2 2-hour sessions for children and parents, with an optional 3rd 2-hour parent session.
- Parents receive help with:
 - Understanding children's divorce-related concerns and responding appropriately
 - Developing a Co-Parental Relationship
 - Strengthening parent-child relationships
- Children learn to:
 - Understand their feelings and change their misperceptions about divorce
 - Cope with anger about divorce
 - Develop coping skills for dealing with divorce
- Children's groups run concurrently with parent groups.
- Separating or divorcing parents must attend separately.
