Domestic Violence Intervention Program (DVIP) is a group treatment for men who have abused their partners with topics including male privilege, power and control, belief systems and their impact on violent behavior.

Women's Domestic Violence Intervention Program (WDVIP) is a women's only program that addresses issues of violence in women's lives by focusing on issues of accountability and responsibility for violent behavior and understanding the negative effects of violence on her intimate relations and children.

Referrals to these programs come from criminal and civil court, Department of Social Services and individuals who self-refer.
