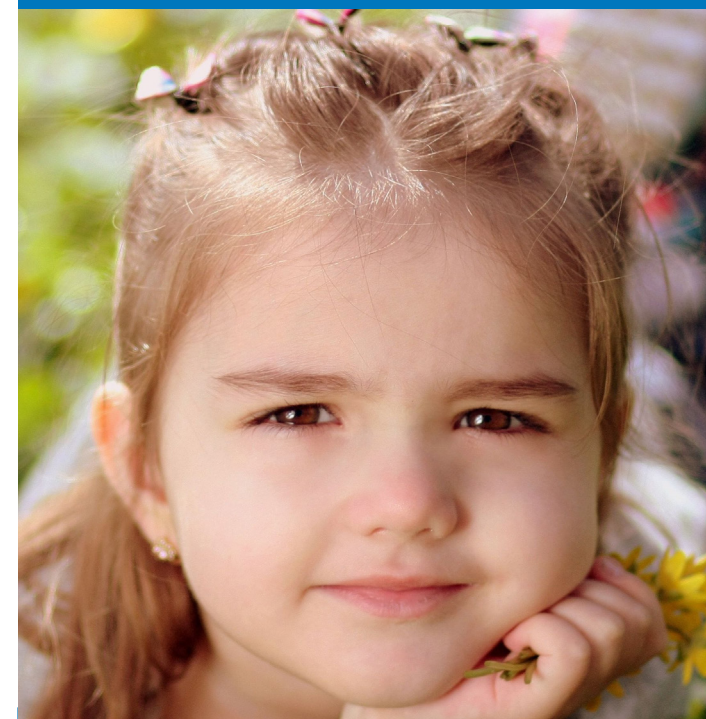

What is Harmony House?

Harmony House provides separated families with a safe environment for supervised child visitation and custody exchanges.

The goal of Harmony House is ensuring safety while promoting fair and respectful treatment of all program participants.



The program is ideal for families where parents are no longer together but are experiencing a high level of conflict.

Interested families may request the services of Harmony House directly or may be referred through Guilford County Social Services or the court system.

At Harmony House professionally-trained facilitators observe child visitations and custody exchanges in a child-friendly and comfortable atmosphere.

Harmony House provides:

- Safety measures such as separate entrances and staggered arrival and departure times for participants
- Playroom settings with a variety of toys including board games, books, and video games
- Commitment to an environment where negative talk about other family members is not permitted
 - Visits that last between one and two hours
 - Evening and weekend appointment options



Harmony House services are provided at a nominal fee for non-custodial/non-primary residential parties, unless otherwise ordered by the court or per agreement between the parties.

Those who meet income requirements may apply for a reduction in fees.
