We have much to celebrate as we close out our 2022-2023 fiscal year. Our agency budget grew by 6% to almost \$11 million. The number of clients served by our highly qualified staff increased by 9.1% to 18,580 individuals and families. We also saw an 11.3% increase in the number of full-time employees, an 8.1% increase in the total number of employees, and a reduction in staff turnover of 6.7%.

A primary contributor to these successes is our adherence to a solid and dynamic strategic plan that allows us to be proactive rather than reactive. Our plan factors into every decision and discussion of the agency and layers in a level of accountability through our quarterly progress meetings.

Our current plan contains strategies and action steps to meet community needs by focusing on innovative, high-impact services reflecting our vision/mission; to develop an agency culture that attracts, retains, and engages talented staff and promotes a positive Agency community; to build infrastructure and fundraising plans to ensure stability and sustainability to support growth.

Another factor in the success of Family Service of the Piedmont is our unwavering commitment to our mission and core values. We are committed to treating all we serve with dignity and respect, resulting in a 95% client satisfaction rate. We serve with honesty, responsibility, transparency, and accountability. We are committed to the safety and health of families in our community and are here to help children and adults overcome issues related to child abuse, domestic violence, sexual assault, mental health, substance use, and financial instability. And we achieve excellence through innovation, flexibility, collaboration, efficiency, and quality of staff and services.

Finally, our success this year would not have been possible without our Board's leadership, our staff's commitment, and the support from our Foundations, Guilds, funders, and volunteers. These folks ensure that Family Service of the Piedmont can meet the needs of more clients more effectively throughout our community.

Shalina’s journey began with dreams of a better life alongside her husband in a new area, but these dreams were shattered by mental, physical, and financial abuse. She felt trapped and began experiencing health issues which forced her to stop working and pushed her into a dark place.

She reached out to Family Service and with the support of a victim advocate, Shalina was able to secure an order of protection and have her unsafe husband removed from their home. Assistance from Family Service with food, prescription medications and bringing her past due rent current helped her to find her footing. With continued encouragement, she took tentative steps back into her workplace and is grateful for the support she received.

Shalina’s transformation is a testament to resilience and the power of a supportive community. Her story reminds us that even in the face of daunting challenges, a network of care can bring renewal and a better life.

Seventeen-year-old Aubrey was dealing with severe depression, anxiety, and suicidal thoughts. She struggled to form relationships with her peers at school, attend social events and experienced frequent panic attacks. Her family contacted Family Service of the Piedmont for help, where Aubrey recieved specialized therpay and support.

Aubrey’s progress was evident thanks to resources and expertise such as weekly individual counseling sessions and support from Family Service. Through therapy she was able to develop healthy forms of coping, overcoming her social anxiety and decreasing her panic attacks.

Over time, her therpay sessions with Family Services evolved from weekly to monthly as she excelled in school and her daily social life.

Aubrey’s success is a testament to her resilience and the hope that comes with access to mental health care for children and young adults.

Miranda began her path to empowerment began when an outpatient mental health clinician referred her to our Healthy Start Program. Her challenges were substantial when facing the weight of past and present domestic violence, financial instability, and the demands of single parenthood. As a devoted single parent to her one and 3-year-old, Miranda juggled child-rearing, work, and therapy appointments.

However, her traumatic history hindered her ability to show affection and understand her children's emotions. With Healthy Start's guidance, she embraced the Nurturing Parenting Curriculum during weekly home visits. This support was a turning point. Miranda accessed vital resources such as clothing, food, childcare, and housing assistance. Despite hurdles, she secured independent housing and stability. Armed with new parenting skills, she learned to provide emotional support, breaking the cycle of her past.

Miranda's journey reflects resilience. With Healthy Start, she discovered empathy, learned effective discipline, and nurtured her children's emotional needs. She continues to flourish today, creating a nurturing environment and fostering solid bonds through daily reading and play.

Mirandas transformation is a tribute to her determination and Healthy Start's impactful support. Her story reminds us that, with assistance and dedication, families can transcend adversity, finding strength, hope, and a brighter future.

Doug Witcher

Doug Witcher's philanthropic spirit combined with his business acumen has made a tremendous impact on the City of High Point and Family Service of the Piedmont. Doug's involvement with Family Service began in 2007 when he joined the Family Service of High Point Foundation board.

Doug, who is the founder and Chief Executive Officer of Smart Choice, began his business in 1979, with the opening of Douglas S. Witcher Insurance in a small window front office. In the more than 40 years since, this start-up has transformed into one of the largest independent insurance agencies in North Carolina. Today, Smart Choice® is the 4th largest privately held agency in the United States and has more than 9,500 offices in 46 states.

Joining the High Point Foundation in 2007 and serving a six year term, Doug immediately began sharing his skills as an integral member of the committee. The investment committee provides oversight of the management of endowment fund assets for the Foundation. Upon the end of his tenure on the foundation, he continued to share his time with Family Service as a member of The Family Service of Piedmont Board of Directors where he served from 2013 to 2014.

A long-time supporter of the agency, Smart Choice was the Presenting Sponsor for the High Point Oyster Roast, the foundation's signature fundraising event, in 2013 and 2014. Doug and Smart Choice have also supported the agency's annual campaign and the Jamestown Pig Pickin'.

Doug shared, "After becoming involved with Family Service, and learning about all the programs they offered. I became excited about giving of my time, talents and financial gifts to an organization that is making a profound difference in the lives of children and families in our community." - Doug Witcher



Dwight Ensley

Dwight Austin Ensley (1957 – 2022) was known as a renaissance man throughout his life. He was an accomplished multi-engine instrument airplane pilot who served as a trainer and mentor to other pilots. He graduated from Kent State University with a degree in Business Administration; he received his MBA from the University of Steubenville and his JD from Elon University School of Law. He was an accomplished musician and frequently played guitar with friends, including select performances at events.

He was inspired by the work of Family Service of the Piedmont and became involved with the agency through its Big Hair Ball, the Greensboro Guild's signature fundraising event. The event which combines a cocktail reception and runway fashion show with imaginative clothing designs and ingenious hair styles, caught the innovative glimmer in Dwight's eye.

His company, ValuePoint.biz became a major sponsor of the Big Hair Ball and Dwight was an active hands-on helper to the designers. On one occasion, he ran errands for the hair designers at Blow, a local hair salon when additional hair extensions were needed to finalize the look for the runway.

Dwight's involvement with Family Service continued when he and his wife, Carolyn, served as co-chairs for the Greensboro Annual Campaign from 2020-2022. They raised a record amount of money for the agency during the uncertain time of the pandemic. Dwight considered his charitable endeavors to be among his best accomplishments.

Before his death in 2022, Dwight and his wife Carolyn Woodruff co-founded the Woodruff Ensley Foundation in furtherance of long-term charitable objectives.

"Dwight's commitment to family went beyond the incredible warmth and care he extended to his own family, says his wife, Carolyn. "Through Family Service of the Piedmont, he was able to extend his dedication to encompass families in need throughout Guilford County. His lifelong motto can be summed up with the Charles D. Meigs classic hymn "Others." "Lord help me live from day to day, in such a self-forgetful way, that even when I kneel to pray, my prayer shall be for others . . . others, let this my motto be."
