We have much to celebrate as we close out our 2022-2023 fiscal year. Our agency budget grew by 6% to almost \$11 million. The number of clients served by our highly qualified staff increased by 9.1% to 18,580 individuals and families. We also saw an 11.3% increase in the number of full-time employees, an 8.1% increase in the total number of employees, and a reduction in staff turnover of 6.7%.

A primary contributor to these successes is our adherence to a solid and dynamic strategic plan that allows us to be proactive rather than reactive. Our plan factors into every decision and discussion of the agency and layers in a level of accountability through our quarterly progress meetings.

Our current plan contains strategies and action steps to meet community needs by focusing on innovative, high-impact services reflecting our vision/mission; to develop an agency culture that attracts, retains, and engages talented staff and promotes a positive Agency community; to build infrastructure and fundraising plans to ensure stability and sustainability to support growth.

Another factor in the success of Family Service of the Piedmont is our unwavering commitment to our mission and core values. We are committed to treating all we serve with dignity and respect, resulting in a 95% client satisfaction rate. We serve with honesty, responsibility, transparency, and accountability. We are committed to the safety and health of families in our community and are here to help children and adults overcome issues related to child abuse, domestic violence, sexual assault, mental health, substance use, and financial instability. And we achieve excellence through innovation, flexibility, collaboration, efficiency, and quality of staff and services.

Finally, our success this year would not have been possible without our Board's leadership, our staff's commitment, and the support from our Foundations, Guilds, funders, and volunteers. These folks ensure that Family Service of the Piedmont can meet the needs of more clients more effectively throughout our community.

Shalina's journey began with dreams of a better life alongside her husband in a new area, but these dreams were shattered by mental, physical, and financial abuse. She felt trapped and began experiencing health issues which forced her to stop working and pushed her into a dark place.

She reached out to Family Service and with the support of a victim advocate, Shalina was able to secure an order of protection and have her unsafe husband removed from their home. Assistance from Family Service with food, prescription medications and bringing her past due rent current helped her to find her footing. With continued encouragement, she took tentative steps back into her workplace and is grateful for the support she received.

Shalina's transformation is a testament to resilience and the power of a supportive community. Her story reminds us that even in the face of daunting challenges, a network of care can bring renewal and a better life.



Seventeen-year-old Aubrey was dealing with severe depression, anxiety, and suicidal thoughts. She struggled to form relationships with her peers at school, attend social events and experienced frequent panic attacks. Her family contacted Family Service of the Piedmont for help, where Aubrey recieved specialized therpay and support.

Aubrey's progress was evident thanks to resources and expertise such as weekly individual counseling sessions and support from Family Service. Through therapy she was able to develop healthy forms of coping, overcoming her social anxiety and decreasing her panic attacks.

Over time, her therpay sessions with Family Services evolved from weekly to monthly as she excelled in school and her daily social life.

Aubrey's success is a testament to her resilience and the hope that comes with access to mental health care for children and young adults.

However, her traumatic history hindered her ability to show affection and understand her children's emotions. With Healthy Start's guidance, she embraced the Nurturing Parenting Curriculum during weekly home visits. This support was a turning point. Miranda accessed vital resources such as clothing, food, childcare, and housing assistance. Despite hurdles, she secured independent housing and stability. Armed with new parenting skills, she learned to provide emotional support, breaking the cycle of her past.

Miranda's journey reflects resilience. With Healthy Start, she discovered empathy, learned effective discipline, and nurtured her children's emotional needs. She continues to flourish today, creating a nurturing environment and fostering solid bonds through daily reading and play.
