Victims of Domestic Violence, Sexual Assault and Other Violent Crimes Cherie, a mother of two, found herself in the hospital with a broken nose after a violent assault by her husband. With no place to go, she stayed at Family Service of the Piedmont's emergency domestic violence shelter for several weeks while working and going to school full time.

In an effort to make her marriage work, she tried couple's counseling with her husband but he returned to abusing her again. The final straw came when Child Protective Services became involved and threatened to take her children away from her.

"I said, 'I am done. I am done. I am done.' The last time he hit me, I saw my life flash before my eyes, and I grabbed a knife to protect myself," she said. "My children mean more to me than anything. It wasn't worth it."

She left her husband, divorcing him a year later, and stayed with her mom. For the past couple of years, she has been receiving counseling services at Family Service to heal from the trauma of the abuse she endured.

Cherie said that she thought that once she left her abuser, she would be able to return to a normal life. She didn't realize she would struggle with post-traumatic stress disorder, having a nervous breakdown in 2018.

"I didn't realized how much the abuse affected me after 14 years of marriage," she said. "It got to the point that it was too much for me to handle mentally and emotionally."

While in therapy, Cherie learned healthy ways to cope with depression and anxiety and recognize patterns of abuse.

"Family Service gave me the option to break free," she said. "And, now, I am a stronger person. I didn't realize how strong I was. I speak up for myself now and am no longer afraid."

Lisa, who struggles with depression and post-traumatic stress disorder, has been seeing Family Service of the Piedmont mental health counselors off and on for almost 20 years.

"My best experiences have been with Family Service. I have a lot of faith in the providers," she said. "They are thoughtful, respectful and caring to clients. I feel like I have made tremendous improvement."

Five years ago, Lisa was in a difficult place in her life, dealing with poverty and homelessness.

"There was no place for me and my children to live. I got into a major depressive episode. In that episode, I had to be hospitalized but was discharged because the hospital didn't have the resources to help me with my condition."

Devastated, Lisa felt stigmatized due to her mental health challenges.

"It was very traumatic. Another source of my PTSD is that I don't have a support system. I don't have parents and a family to assist me," she said. "Being sick and trying to take care of yourself while you are sick is very difficult. It makes it difficult to make good choices."

Growing up, Lisa lived in a tumultuous environment with family members who were addicted to drugs and alcohol. Abused as a child, she was first homeless at 17 years old. She said she has been able to improve her life at Family Service with medication management and therapy.

Engaging in group therapy and speaking to a therapist once a week, Lisa has learned techniques tailored to her needs and situation, including practicing mindfulness and thinking things through before taking action.

Leslie, a single mother, dreamed of a more stable life for herself and her three daughters and granddaughter. Living with the help of government assisted housing, she was determined to fix her credit and improve her finances. However, when she suddenly lost the use of her car due to a \$1,000 car repair, she didn't see a way to make that happen.

At first, Leslie tried commuting to and from work using a ridesharing service but the monthly cost was too high. She then found a job closer to her house that would allow her to use her culinary degree and walk to and from work every day and to carpool when she could, but it was still difficult making ends meet.

It was through her caseworker at the Housing Authority of the City of High Point that she learned about Family Service of the Piedmont's Consumer Credit Counseling Service.

At Family Service, she meets with a financial counselor who has helped her save enough money to get her car fixed through a matched savings program. The program doubled her savings toward the car repair, and she is now able to drive to work and has money saved for future emergencies. She has learned to create a budget plan, watch her expenses and save as much money as possible.

She said that having someone to talk to and count on has helped her improve her self-esteem and her life.

"No matter how many times I wanted to give up, there is always hope," she said. "You have to believe in yourself and tell yourself that you can do it. I am more confident now, and I would recommend their services to people who need help and want to be successful."

Dr. Lenny Peters' love and care for patients as a doctor extends to his philanthropic generosity toward his community through the Lenny Peters Foundation. Engaged with Family Service of the Piedmont since 2016, he has supported the agency's efforts to raise funds for its programs and services.

Lenny, who is the chief executive officer of Bethany Medical, began his foundation, a non-profit organization that supports the Triad and communities around the world, out of a desire to give back to the community. His calling is to help people in need, and his foundation supports local area non-profit organizations including Family Service.

"I was born and raised in a poor home in southern India. I understand poverty," he said. "I understand how poverty can destroy the fabric of a family. So, I started working with my foundation to help orphaned children in poor families. In our community, I have chosen Family Service as the entity that I focus my help."

His foundation has been the presenting sponsor of the High Point Oyster Roast from 2016 to 2020, and he generously hosted the event at his home in 2016 and 2020. The foundation was also a top sponsor of the Big Hair Ball from 2018 to 2020, and he was the honorary chair of the event in 2020. It was also a presenting sponsor of the Jamestown Pig Pickin' in 2016 and 2017.

"I learned how much hard work goes into the various events and fundraisers Family Service coordinates every year to raise funds to help the community address mental health issues, domestic violence, child abuse and financial instability," he said. "These funds go to critical services that lift people out of poverty and help them live better lives.

Lenny is a member of the Families First Honor Society, which is comprised of the agency's closest supporters and friends.

"I was always involved with helping families through my charitable foundation," he said. "I became aware of the wonderful programs and services Family Service offers to keep our families safe and healthy 10 years ago both in High Point and in Greensboro. The agency does so much for our community."

Gwendolyn D. Willis' 40 years' experience working directly with clients with substance use disorders and as a social service leader led her to join the Family Service of the Piedmont Board of Directors in 2011, where she generously gave her time and support to the agency.

In her career, she was the chief student services officer at Guilford County Schools and has also served as the director of student services and substance abuse programs for the High Point school system. She also served as executive director and, prior to that role, a counselor at the Alcohol Education Center. It was her familiarity with Family Service as a referral source for clients, students, families and staff that motivated her to serve on the board.

"I was honored when I was asked to be a member of the board because of my appreciation for the excellent services the agency provides to individuals and families," she said.

Gwendolyn served on the board as secretary from 2012 to 2014, vice chair from 2016 to 2017, chair from 2017 to 2018 and immediate past chair from 2018 to 2019. In addition to participating in monthly Executive Committee, Finance Committee and board meetings, she has served on the Audit, Advancement, Nominating, Strategic Planning, Programs and Services, and Sexual Assault Awareness committees.

"My commitment to the mission of Family Service has continued to grow over the years as my professional and personal knowledge of the quality of services provided has grown," she said. "The agency's mission: to empower individuals and families to restore hope, achieve stability, and thrive through quality support services, advocacy and education, aligns with my philosophy as an educator, certified substance abuse counselor and clinical supervisor."

Gwendolyn has encouraged board participation in the Annual Campaign and continued the tradition of the friendly competition between the agency's three boards, treating the board who reached their goal first to lunch. She has also worked with the volunteer group Greensboro Chapter of Links, Inc., hosting book drives for the Healthy Start program for several years.

She and her husband, Don, have also been loyal longtime supporters of the agency's fundraisers in Greensboro, High Point and Jamestown.

"I believe that anyone can need help at a given time in their lives," she said. "Receiving assistance from professionals can facilitate the restoration and stabilization of the family unit. The well trained agency staff provide assistance and treatment interventions to families and individuals in the areas of domestic violence, child abuse, financial stability and mental health."
